

9th-12th Grade Supply List – Fall 2017

We expect the students to start the year with the following materials:

- A USB Flash Drive (at least 8 GB) for Technology class and for saving computer-generated documents
- College Ruled loose-leaf filler paper
- Graph Ruled loose-leaf filler paper
- 5 Pocket folders
- 1 composition graphing notebook (9th & 10th grade)
Staples carries a few different types. Descriptions are below.
 - Item 394765 Model 06497 Mead Neatbook® Combo 4"/5" Quadrille Notebook, 8.5" x 11"
 - Item 716522 Model 11625AM-US Staples® Quadrille 4x4 Spiral Notebook, 8"x10.5"
- 1 x 1½-inch binders (use for all classes)
- 1 x 3-inch binder (remains home to store old school work)
- 10 dividers to be used with binders
- **DO NOT buy a planner yet.** Special BSGE planners will be available in September for students to purchase. These will include information specifically pertaining to BSGE and most likely be cheaper than what is available in stores.
- Tech class (9th grade): Ear bugs or headphones to use with computers
- 11th & 12th grade: 3in X 5in index cards

We expect students to carry their “tool kits” with them to each class.

The tool kit should contain the following:

- 2 black or blue pens
- 2 pencils and a large eraser
- 2 highlighters – different colors
- A pencil case to hold your supplies
- A ruler with both inches and cm
- Compass (for Geometry: 9th graders who passed the Algebra Regents)
- Reinforcements (page savers)
- 1 pad of Post-It notes (3x3) or larger
- Colored pencils (at least 6 different colors)
- Graphing Calculator (TI 83 or TI 84) please etch your name onto the back of the calculator. Do not simply use a sticker or marker!

***Please do not bring all of the materials on the first day of class. Teachers will give you specific directions as to what will be needed when. Depending on the student’s schedule, some teachers may ask for additional materials once the school year begins. Students should only need their 1.5-inch binder, folders, loose-leaf paper, and their tool kits for the first day of classes.
